Southeast Asia May Reward Shrewd Insurers, Punish the Careless

Southeast Asia is seen as an exciting and rapidly developing insurance market, A.M. Best believes the insurance markets in Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Thailand and Vietnam will continue to grow. Each market in this region has unique risks and opportunities, but also challenges that require insurers to approach them with care.

- These insurance markets are less mature than established markets, such as Singapore, and certain countries in Southeast Asia have more fragmented insurance markets than some markets in Northeast Asia.
- Traditional and Islamic insurance are increasingly offered in certain countries in Southeast Asia, which includes large Muslim populations in Indonesia and Malaysia who could be attracted to Sharia-compliant products.
- Use of reinsurance and insurance pools is increasing in Southeast Asia, particularly in the Philippines.
- Insurance markets in the region are likely to attract more global interest as regulatory structures develop, and particularly in some cases that move toward adopting (or based) capital (RBC) standards.
- Many overseas insurers have established a presence in Southeast Asia, which could increase with the more liberal RBC standards.
- Insurance markets in Southeast Asia have shown some resilience and attracted new business despite tough economic conditions, but profitable underwriting can be challenging as the markets tend to exhibit intense competition.
- A.M. Best believes insurers should focus on profitable underwriting and expense control—depending on investment success—but the strategy is likely to induce regional volatility.
