

The book goes beyond tricks and gets into the how and why - it is book designed for the intermediate and above skill level - there are a few tricks that require little technical skill but require some performance skill. The following couple of questions will gauge the required skill level and help you decide if this book is appropriate (the reason is this book should not fall into the wrong hands or frustrate the reader.)1.
