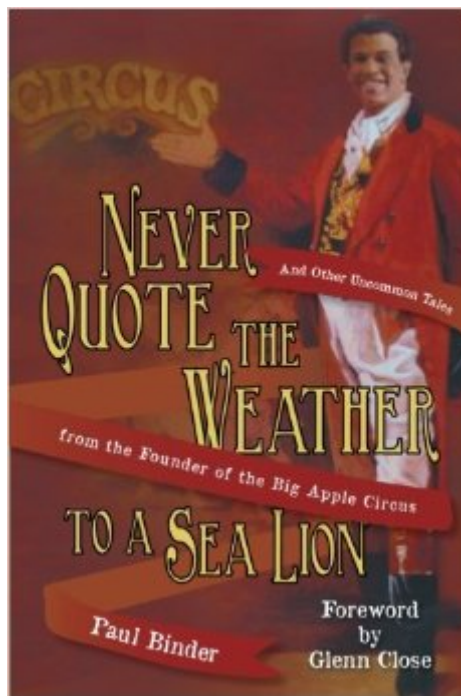

Mr. Binder's stories are entertaining, witty, and often moving, as he chronicles his life in and out of the circus ring. Yes, there are plenty of great behind-the-scenes stories here, but also some insight into a man who started with an idea and founded what is an institution in New York City. The chutzpah required to start a circus from the ground up and keep it running for 30 years? It's evident as you breeze through this terrific collection of stories from a legendary figure.

This is a great and fast moving story of a boy from Brooklyn who eschews his Ivy League world for

the life under the big top. It's a fun and well written story of Paul Binder's journey from that of a broke and novice juggler to that of the creator and star of a world renowned circus. The book could be the essence of a Harvard Business School case study or as the next Dr. Seuss children's book. Don't miss it. It's fast moving and very entertaining and a happy insight into life under the big top.
