That is my only complaint. When we were done reading it my son just kind of looked at me like "that's it?" haha. It is a very basic book. The vocabulary is kind of big but it has really great explanations for the words. It might

actually be geared more toward the Kindergarten audience. Which actually worked out great for me! The pictures are really great. Some are very simple and others are quite detailed. My son enjoyed looking at them and asking questions and pointing out little things in each one. We are very big fans of ebooks. Just know that this book wouldn't be very good on the paperwhite (black and white version) because this book is in color and it just wouldn't look that great. We have used it on the iPad and the computer and it looks great. I love that I can load a bunch of these types of books up onto my iPad for trips and he has the ability to flip through tons of books without the huge bag of books!
